

- All games consist of three (15 minute) stop clock periods
- Automatic Red Line Icing
- Tag up offsides
- 2 Minute minor penalties, 5 Minute Major Fighting Penalty
- First offense for FIGHTING is a one game suspension. Second offense is a minimum suspension for the remainder of the season.
- Player is ejected from a game at the time of their THIRD PENALTY in a single game. Penalties of any duration count towards this rule. First offense is time served, second offense can be a one game suspension, per league disgression.
- If a game reaches a goal differential of 7 goals as of the start of the third period or later the game will become running clock, to only become stop clock if the goal differential becomes less then 7 again. If a game reaches a goal differential of 10 goals at the conclusion of the second period the game will be considered over.
- If the game is tied at the end of regulation e teams will immediatly continue to an "NHL" style shootout. There will be three shooters per team, if the game is still tied after the three shooters it will go to one and one rotating between the teams until the tie is broken.
- Any player currently serving a penalty at the end of regulation is ineligible to take part in the shootout.
- If a team does not have a goalie and the game goes into a shootout the team with no goalie will be considered the loser.
- Any team the pays a team fee may roster up to 18 different skaters throughout the season. Team fee is to be made in no more then 2 installments by midseason.
- Any team that is short on players may use a substitute player as long as the player fills out a registration form and pays the walk-on fee of \$30.00 prior to playing in the game. Players will be removed from the ice for nonpayment or in order to fill out the registration. A rink employee may also be used if the team in need has less then 10 dressed skaters and has less dressed skaters then their opponent.
- Players may be added at any point in the regular season to a teams roster as long as they pay a Minimum of a half season payment. No players may be added during the playoffs, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Players must dedicate themselves to one team. Any player that plays for another team in the same Division must pay a per game fee. No Player, excluding goalies, is eligible to play for any team other than their originally designated team during playoffs.
- All League players must be atleast 18 years of age prior to the first game of the season. Players mustalso be at the talent level of the league that they play in, any player playing down a division in the League can possibly be removed to ensure no "TEAM STACKING".
- The officials may terminate play at any time due to uncontrollable or violent behavior. The current score will relect the winner, unless the violence is one sided committed by the team with the lead, which that team would then be considered to forfeit the game.
- All Teams must have matching jerseys, with a number on back and no duplicate numbers.
